Concealed and Open Carry Sign Postings Guidance

Many Churches and schools have shared access points and are mixed-use properties. Parish buildings that share space with a school still need to post 30.06 and 30.07 at parish entrances. Separate and distinct school buildings do not need to post the 30.06 and 30.07 signage. Federal and State laws explicitly prohibit guns from all school property, with no exceptions. Other types of signs are available for these facilities.
