CRS Rice Bowl - Lent 2018

The season of Lent is just around the corner, beginning February 14th, 2018. All parishes are invited to "share the journey" with us and Catholic Relief Services (CRS) with the yearly Lenten formation program, Rice Bowl. Through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving we unite ourselves closer to Jesus and in solidarity with our brothers and sisters in need around the world.

CRS Rice Bowl is not to be confused with the CRS Collection, which occurs this year on March 11th. These are two separate programs. The funds for the CRS Collection go to 6 different Catholic Organizations; CRS happens to be one of them.

Unlike the CRS Collection, 75% of the proceeds from Rice Bowl go to support programs overseas, 25% remains in our diocese for local programs. None of the money from the CRS Collection on March 11th comes back to our diocese.
