Canonization of Blessed Junípero Serra

Catholics around the world are rejoicing in Pope Francis's decision to canonize Blessed Junípero Serra during the Holy Father's upcoming visit to the United States. Father Serra, an 18th century Franciscan friar, left a very comfortable life in Spain to come to the New World and share his love of the Gospel. He was so dedicated that he walked thousands of miles across what is now California and Mexico to spread the faith, establishing nine missions along the way in California. His efforts to promote Catholicism are continued by the four Serra Clubs of the Dallas Diocese. Particularly, the clubs encourage and sustain religious vocations. The canonization will take place September 23, 2015, at the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C.
