Relics of St. Maria Goretti: The relics of St. Maria Goretti will be at St. Monica Catholic Church located at 9933 Midway Rd., Dallas, TX 75220, 214-358-1453, on Tuesday, November 3rd from 11:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m. with Mass at 7:00 p.m. that evening. St. Maria Goretti was martyred when she was twelve in Corinaldo, Italy. Relics include the physical remains of a saint as well as other objects that have been "sanctified" since touched by the saint's body. Veneration is part of the history of the Church as early as 156 CE. Feast days of saints developed from the notion of veneration. Relics remind us of the holiness of a saint and her cooperation in God's work. The norm for veneration is quiet devotional prayer usually in the presence of the relic(s). Please see the flyers at the entrance of the Church.


